Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to be accepting applications for the second year for **Dig It! Garden Apprenticeship**. Please read over this information sheet with your child **before** submitting the application. Only children ages 11-14 are eligible. Your child must complete the application without the aid of an adult. **Apprenticeship applications are due no later than May 29th**. Applications submitted after May 29th will not be eligible. You will be notified by the June 8th if your child is or is not chosen.

Dates:

Every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, July 17th to August 9th (12 sessions total)

9:00AM – 12:00PM (Drop off: 8:30 – 9AM, Pick up: 12-12:30PM)

Program Details:

Ten top applicants will be selected as a garden apprentices for a 4-week (12 sessions) experience at Moore Farms Botanical Garden. Not all who apply will be selected.

Responsibilities include designing and caring for our vegetable garden. Apprentices will participate in a variety of team building activities and learn about gardening/agricultural skills and practices, our food system, land stewardship, agricultural history and nutrition. Upon successful completion of the program, apprentices will receive a monetary award.*

***Apprentices must successfully complete 9 of the 12 sessions to earn a monetary award of \$100.** Apprentices who miss more than 3 full sessions will still be able to participate, but will not be eligible to receive the monetary award.
